She had a private psychotherapy practice in New York City with individuals and couples from 1982-2002. Dr. Aiken is listed in thirteen Who's Who books, and has appeared on television and radio. She is a speaker with an international reputation, and has lectured for diverse groups in more than 200 cities worldwide.
